

Rep. John Campbell this week called President Barack Obama's budget proposal "falling down, throwing up, passing out, wasted on spending and deficit."

Speaking out at a House of Representatives budget committee meeting, Campbell compared Obama's \$3.6-trillion budget proposal to an all-night drinking binge.

Addressing Democratic lawmakers' arguments that past Republican budgets ran deficits that were too high, Campbell tossed out a tipsy analogy, railing against the large amount of spending contained in the budget proposal.

"If those Republican budgets were the spending- and deficit-equivalent of a couple of drinks when you get home at night, this budget is falling down, throwing up, passing out wasted on spending and deficits," Campbell said. "This budget is so severe and so extreme, it goes way beyond what anyone else has even considered."
