

Campbell Earns *Defender of Economic Freedom Award*

Club for Growth Honors Campbell's Support For Economic Growth and Freedom in Congress

Washington, D.C. – The Club for Growth, the nation’s leading free-market advocacy organization, with over 55,000 members, announced that Congressman John Campbell has earned the annual *Defender of Economic Freedom* award. The award honors Members of Congress who have a strong, consistent voting record on economic growth issues. Campbell, ranking in the highest percentile, received a 100% rating and was distinguished by the Club for votes in 2010 that represented “highest support” for pro-growth policies.

“With his score of 100%, and a lifetime score of 90%, Congressman Campbell has demonstrated that he is on the side of economic freedom not just at election time, but every time,” said Club for Growth President Chris Chocola. **“The Club for Growth values Members of Congress who stand on principle over political expediency. The people of the 48th district of California are lucky to have strong pro-growth representation in Congress.”**

The Club’s Congressional Scorecard included 19 House roll call votes, as well as other selected actions that advanced or harmed pro-growth, deficit-reduction policies. Points were also added to lawmakers who signed the Club for Growth’s “Repeal It” pledge to sponsor and support legislation to repeal the 2010 federal health care law.

The rating examines legislative actions that affect immediate pro-economic growth policy goals, including:

- ☐ Lower marginal income tax rates

- ☐ Death Tax repeal
- ☐ Expanding free trade
- ☐ Legal reform to end abusive lawsuits
- ☐ Replacing the current tax code
